When inspecting the First Aid Stations ensure each station is clearly labeled with the universal signage for First Aid and the required items are present, in good order, sterile, not expired, etc. Each First Aid Station will have a recognized First Aid Manual (i.e. St. John), First Aid Register, copy of the First Aid Emergency Plan, copy of the Emergency Phone Numbers. Indicate on this form any other first aid supplies or first aid equipment which are appropriate to the potential risk of danger observed for that environment.

Submit this form to the manager of the facility once completed, for purchasing and restocking requirements. Initial in the column to verify you have checked all items. Items needing replaced will be done so immediately.
